Team reaches safety milestone

THE Komatsu Australia contract team at Ensham Mine recently achieved a major safety milestone, with seven-and-a-half years without lost time injury.

The time equates to more than 2700 work days without an injury having been reported.

The Komatsu team is responsible for maintaining all mobile heavy equipment operated by Ensham Mine, which will this year produce over eight million tonnes of product coal.

Komatsu's area contract manager James Craig has praised the efforts

of those involved.

"This is an outstanding achievement and one that all employees and the company should be proud of," he said.

"Our priority is zero injuries nationally and the Ensham team, led by Phil Moore, is showing the way."

Ensham Mine general manager of operations Peter Westerhuis also congratulated the Komatsu contract team.
